We are finalists of the **Agentic Loop House Hackathon within muShanghai (Shanghai, China, May 10 – June 6, 2026)**. We are building **Grinta**, an agentic-first stablecoin protocol based on PID controllers, natively designed for autonomous agents to use without friction.

Our key technical differentiators:

- **Agentic Governance** (Agent as Governor): a small RL-trained model that adjusts risk parameters in real time during market crashes.
- **Parameters Guard**: dynamic protection system for critical protocol parameters.
- **Near-zero inference** cost and faster responses than large models, running on the same GPU.

We have already obtained solid results in initial tests (improved stability, reduced reaction times) and want to continue our research during the hackathon and on the ground in Asia.
